Solicitation 1084-27-5000 - Sex Offense Specific Treatment

5012, 6012, 6022, 6032, 6090 -Sex Offense Specific Treatment – (Lea, Eddy, Chavez County, NM Catchment.) - Rural areas, including Indian Country (reservations), are chronically underserved communities in the area of sex offender treatment, often due to geographic and cultural barriers. The availability of professionals rendering these vital services in the areas described are severely limited or non-existent. In addition to the standard requirements included in the Request for Proposals, in order to meet the need for treatment in rural/remote or Indian Country locations, the vendor may utilize video teleconference and/or telephonic equipment to provide and support the above-listed treatment services under the following requirements:

Vendor shall provide video teleconference and/or telephonic services pursuant to the authorized Probation Form 45. Furthermore, the vendor must provide face-to-face therapeutic sessions within the defined catchment area at a minimum of every 30 calendar days. The vendor is authorized to conduct in-person counseling sessions for the above listed project codes at the U.S. Probation Office located at 500 N.

Richardson, Room 309, Roswell, NM 88201, which is located within the identified catchment area.

The vendor shall ensure agency staff is present during treatment sessions and facilitate the completion of required paperwork (e.g. sign-in logs).

Upon prior approval of the USPO, the vendor may provide the required service(s) within space and facilities provided by the USPO located within the identified catchment area.

NOTE: This requirement is in lieu of the provisions set forth in the Request for Proposal which requires the vendor (and any proposed subcontractor) to maintain an acceptable facility located within the defined catchment area). All travel and lodging expenses associated with providing these services shall be the financial responsibility of the vendor and shall be factored into the unit costs provided for under this service code.
